The Lord hates six things; in fact, seven are detestable to Him: 17 arrogant eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, 18 a heart that plots wicked schemes, feet eager to run to evil, 19 a lying witness who gives false testimony, and one who stirs up trouble among brothers. ~ **Proverbs 6:16-19**

Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old self with its practices... ~ **Colossians 3:9**

Since you put away lying, Speak the truth, each one to his neighbor, because we are members of one another. ~ **Ephesians 4:25**

2. _____

I will destroy anyone who secretly slanders his neighbor; I cannot tolerate anyone with haughty eyes or an arrogant heart. ~ **Psalms 101:5**

Do not love the world or the things that belong to the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not



in him. 16For everything that belongs to the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride in one’s lifestyle—is not from the Father, but is from the world. 17And the world with its lust is passing away, but the one who does God’s will remains forever. ~ **1 John 2:15-17**

1. Always _____

One day the sons of God came again to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan also came with them to present himself before the Lord. 2 The Lord asked Satan, “Where have you come from?” “From roaming through the earth,” Satan answered Him, “and walking around on it.” 3 Then the Lord said to Satan, “Have you considered My servant Job? No one else on earth is like him, a man of perfect integrity, who fears God and turns away from evil. He still retains his integrity, even though you incited Me against him, to destroy him without just cause.” ~ **Job 2:1-3**

His wife said to him, “Do you still retain your integrity? Curse God and die!” ~ **Job 2:9**

...as long as my breath is still in me and the breath from God remains in my nostrils, 4 my lips will not speak unjustly, and my tongue will not utter deceit. 5 I will never affirm that you are right. I will maintain my integrity until I die. 6 I will cling to my righteousness and never let it go. My conscience will not accuse me as long as I live! ~ **Job 27:3-6**

Therefore, everyone who will acknowledge Me before men, I will also acknowledge him before My Father in heaven. 33 But whoever denies Me before men, I will also deny him before My Father in heaven. ~ **Matthew 10:32-33**
