After these things **God tested Abraham** and said to him, “Abraham!”

“Here I am,” he answered.

²“Take your son,” He said, “your only son Isaac, whom you love, go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about.”

- **Genesis 22:1-2**

Now the earth was corrupt in God’s sight, and the earth was filled with wickedness. ¹² God saw how corrupt the earth was, for every creature had corrupted its way on the earth. ¹³ Then God said to Noah, “I have decided to put an end to every creature, for the earth is filled with wickedness because of them; therefore I am going to destroy them along with the earth.

Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and cover it with pitch inside and outside.

- **Genesis 6:14**

Understand that I am bringing a flood—floodwaters on the earth to destroy every creature under heaven with the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will die. ¹⁸**But I will establish My covenant with you**, and you will enter the ark with your sons, your wife, and your sons’ wives.

So Abraham **got up early in the morning**, saddled his donkey, and took with him two of his young men and his son Isaac. He split wood for a burnt offering and set out to go to the place God had told him about. ⁴On the third day Abraham looked up and saw the place in the distance. ⁵Then Abraham said to his young men, “Stay here with the donkey. The boy and I will go over there to worship; then we’ll come back to you.” ⁶Abraham took the wood for the burnt offering and laid it on his son Isaac. In his hand he took the fire and the sacrificial knife, and the two of them walked on together.

⁷Then Isaac spoke to his father Abraham and said, “My father.” And he replied, “Here I am, my son.” Isaac said, “The fire and the wood are here, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?” ⁸Abraham answered, “**God Himself will provide the lamb** for the burnt offering, my son.” Then the two of them walked on together. ⁹When they arrived at the place that God had told him about, Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood. He bound his son Isaac and placed him on the altar on top of the wood. ¹⁰Then Abraham reached out and took the knife **to slaughter his son**.

Hebrew: הוֹרֵי מַלְאָכִים "Malahk Adonai" – Angel of the Lord (Theophany)

¹²Then He said, "Do not lay a hand on the boy or do anything to him. For now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your only son from Me." ¹³Abraham looked up and saw a ram caught in the thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram and offered it as a burnt offering in place of his son. ¹⁴And Abraham named that place The Lord Will Provide, so today it is said: "It will be provided on the Lord's mountain."

- **Genesis 22:12-14**

Hebrew: הַאֲרִי הוֹרֵי "Adonai Ireh" (Jehovah Jirah) "God will see"

Now faith is the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen. ²For our ancestors won God's approval by it.

Then the Angel of the Lord called to Abraham a second time from heaven ¹⁶and said, "By Myself I have sworn," this is the Lord's declaration: "Because you have done this thing and have not withheld your only son, ¹⁷I will indeed bless you and make your offspring as numerous as the stars of the sky and the sand on the seashore. Your offspring will possess the gates of their enemies. ¹⁸And all the nations of the earth will be blessed by your offspring because you have obeyed My command."

⁷then understand that those who have faith are Abraham's sons. ⁸Now the Scripture saw in advance that God would justify the Gentiles by faith and told the good news ahead of time to Abraham, saying, All the nations will be blessed through you.
