In Minnesota, financial institutions have been asked to suspend foreclosures and late fees on mortgage payments. As of March 24, evictions have been suspended for the duration of the state's peacetime emergency.

- Students do not have to be enrolled in Prior Lake - Savage Area Schools to receive a free meal.
- Children do not need to qualify for free and reduced meals to receive these meals.
- Families should drive up and roll down their passenger window and a staff member will deliver your meals curb-side.
