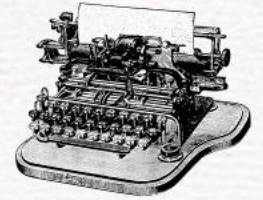


First Century:

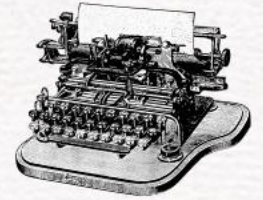


3. Enoch “walked with God” and so do you

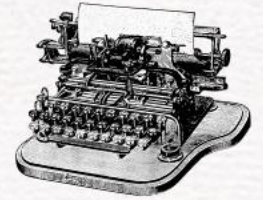


5. Enoch was taken by God

Genesis 5:24

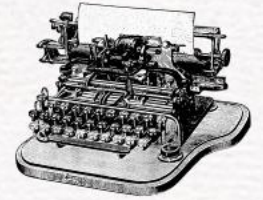
